On Friday, August 23, 2019 the City Comanche received notice that the City water source is clear and citizens can return to normal water usage.

Thank you all for your patience during this crisis. To return to normal usage:


1. Open your faucets and let them run for just a few minutes to clear your lines. You may observe sediment in the water from your taps. We are told the appearance of sediment is normal and is not cause for alarm. You may see City of Comanche water crews flushing lines around the City. This will be normal activities and may include flushing fire hydrants.
2. You no longer are required to boil water prior to your consumption.
3. Toilet use is back to normal. If you closed the valves to fill your toilets you may reopen those valves.
4. Showers and the washing of laundry may go back to your normal schedule.
5. You may resume the normal watering of your lawns.
6. The City of Comanche pool will update their hours of operation soon.

Operation "Pay it Forward" is now in effect.

1. The water that has been donated will be sent to those in need. There is already a plan in place and this plan is being implemented.
2. The ice that was donated will follow the same plan as the water mentioned in number 1 above.
3. The portable bathrooms will be picked up and removed from the square. The company responsible has been contacted and will be sending their trucks for removal of the bathrooms.
4. The showers and laundry provided at the First Baptist Church will no longer be available.
