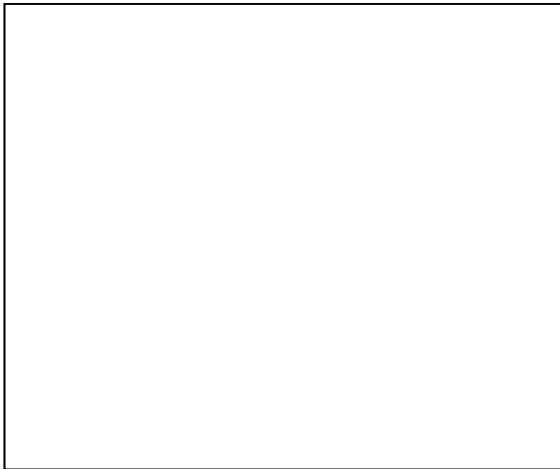
ROYCE LUBKE, VICE-CHAIRMAN
