The Comanche Police Department is currently hiring for a full-time police officer position. The following are the job description and requirements for this position:

Job Description:

Police Officers will be given assignments as needed to improve the lives and ensure the safety of the citizens of Comanche, Texas. Officers are required to be fit for duty and be able to endure strenuous as well as stressful situations in all types of weather and environment conditions. The standard duties of a police officer are listed below but will also include duties as assigned by the Chief of Police or his designee:

- Identify, pursue, and arrest suspects and perpetrators of criminal acts.
- Provide for public safety by maintaining order, responding to emergencies, protecting people and property, enforcing motor vehicle and criminal laws, and promoting good community relations.
- Record facts to prepare reports that document incidents and activities.
- Provide testimony as a witness in court.

Job Requirements:

- 1. Minimum age is 21.
- 2. High School Diploma or GED completion.
- 3. Pass a background investigation.
- 4. Pass a polygraph examination.
- Pass an oral interview.
- Pass a physical examination, psychological screening, and a drug test.
- 7. Be of good moral character.
- 8. Any other standards set by law or by the policy of the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.

The following are disqualifiers for employment:

- 1. Conviction or admission of any felony.
- 2. Conviction of any Class A or B Misdemeanor in the past ten years.
- 3. Conviction or admission of marijuana use within the past two years, or of any other illegal drug within the past five years.
- Conviction of family violence in the past ten years.
- 5. Dishonorable discharge from the military.
